

I am excited to be working at Isuroon and look forward to the opportunity to make a difference in the lives of Afghan refugees and other people served by Isuroon's ARMHS program as a clinical supervisor. I am a social worker. I grew up in Minneapolis, I obtained a masters degree in social work in 1994.

In the field of social work I have worked as a school social worker for Minneapolis Public Schools, as a Minnesota child protection worker, as a community social worker, and as a volunteer psychotherapist.

Other positions I have held in the health services and social services include a being a part-time counselor with adults with sever intellectual



challenges living in group homes, a job coach and assistant case manager for people with developmental disabilities attending day programs, and a nursing assistant for senior citizens and others living in assisted living facilities, nursing homes and transitional care centers.

I currently have a license as a social worker from the State of New York (LMSW) and a certificate as a nursing assistant from the State of Minnesota.
