The Isuroon family is heartbroken by the tragic events that unfolded earlier this month—acts of senseless violence that have deeply shaken our state and touched those closest to our hearts. We begin by lifting up **Senator John Hoffman**, a devoted public servant and steadfast friend of Isuroon. Senator Hoffman and his wife, Yvette, survived a targeted assassination attempt in their Champlin home—both suffering multiple gunshot wounds. Their survival is nothing short of miraculous. As they begin a long road to recovery, we send our love, strength, and unshakable support.

Senator Hoffman has been more than a policymaker—he has been a **true ally**, advocating for culturally grounded health access, equity, and dignity for immigrant and underserved communities. He has listened, shown up, and used his voice to amplify the needs of those too often overlooked. His compassion and commitment have shaped policy and changed lives.

While we are grateful that the Hoffmans survived, we are devastated by the lives lost in the second

We mourn the tragic deaths of **State Representative Melissa Hortman** and her husband, **Mark Hortman**—taken from us far too soon. Melissa was a trailblazer in Minnesota politics: the first woman to lie in state at the Capitol, a champion for ALS research, and a fierce defender of justice. Mark was her lifelong partner and quiet supporter, known for his warmth and deep devotion. Their loss is a blow to our entire state.

These tragedies remind us of the deep risks that come with public service—and the profound human cost of political violence.

As we grieve, we also recommit ourselves to the values that John Hoffman, Melissa Hortman, and Mark Hortman lived by: **service**, **inclusion**, **courage**, **and compassion**.

To Senator Hoffman and Yvette: we are with you. To the Hortman family: we mourn with you. To all Minnesotans: let us unite in healing, remembrance, and the pursuit of peace.

We also provide 245D waiver services and ARHMS mental health programs to support independence and recovery.
